## Letter of Accomplishment Guidelines

The purpose of a Letter of Accomplishment is to put in writing, your intentions as the Leader of your life. Your letter of accomplishment is yours; your ideas, your dreams, your goals, the difference you'll make in the world.

These are the areas that you will create your letter of accomplishment or "LOA" from.

Your personal goals for yourself in:

- a) school i.e....grades in any or all of your subjects
- b) spirituality i.e.... either a religion you practice or your desire to seek a deeper understanding of yourself and life
- c) your relationship with your family i.e.... your mother or father, brothers/sisters
- d) Your relationships with your friends i.e.... more effective communication of your interests and goals, creating trust and trustworthiness
- e) Hobbies and interests' i.e.... quantifiable improvement in sports, music, performance arts or whatever it is you choose to improve.
- f) Contribution /areas in life you would choose to make a difference i.e.... Community service at hospitals, in your neighborhoods, at your school, church, synagogue, or mosques
- g) Your career and future i.e.... goals to set you up to accomplish a life worth living
- h) A personal subject that is important to you that may not have been mentioned above.

This letter of accomplishment will be completed in the time between your first and second weekend. It shall be specific in nature; generalities will only accomplish mediocrity. It shall be type written and due Saturday of second weekend.
